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### The terms of reference of the Committees are as follows:

- 1. Direct the collection and collation of data regarding urban mobility viz. land use, building construction activities, vehicle registration etc. by the concerned Departments and Offices.
- 2. Consider the potential issues identified and take decisions thereof for the concerned departments to comply with.
- 3. To Monitor, through an appropriate mechanism, the state of adherence to service level benchmarks for urban mobility.
- 4. Authorize review of, and amendment to the comprehensive mobility plan as is adopted by the Government of Mizoram for Aizawl.
- 5. To explore the possibilities to increase funding for improvement of traffic management in Aizawl and suggest financing mechanism.
- 6. Review the workings of the various laws, rules & regulations as regards to remove impediments/ difficulties in terms of its functioning.
- 7. The committee shall hold a half yearly meeting (at every 6 months; before 15<sup>th</sup> July and 15<sup>th</sup> January) or as desired by the Chairman.
