Terms of reference:

- 1. The Selection committee shall be responsible for selection of Members of the Juvenile Justice Board or Chairperson and Members of the Child Welfare Committee and shall carry out its function in accordance with the procedure as laid down under Rule 87 & 88 of the Mizoram Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Rules, 2019.
- 2. The quorum for the meeting of the Selection Committee shall not be less than four Members, including the Chairperson & Member Secretary.
- 3. The Committee shall have tenure of three years from the issue of this Notification and the tenure of Chairperson and Members shall be co-terminus with the tenure of Committee.
- 4. The Committee shall continue for a maximum period of three months after completion of its tenure by which time new Committee shall be constituted.
