ANNEXURE-I

Terms, conditions and duties of the State Board for Wildlife Mizoram shall be as follows:

- 1) The Board shall meet at least twice a year at such place as the State Government may direct.
- 2) The Board shall regulate its own procedure (including the quorum).
- 3) No act or proceeding of the Board shall be invalid merely by reasons of the existence of any vacancy therein or any defect in the constitution thereof or any irregularity in the procedure of the Board not affecting the merits of the case.
- 4) It shall be duty of the State Board for Wildlife to advise the State Government-
 - (a) In the selection and management of areas to be declared as protected areas;
 - (b) In formulation of the policy for protection and conservation of the Wildlife and specified plants;
 - (c) In any matter relating to the amendment of any schedule;
[(CC) in relation to the measures to be taken for harmonizing the needs of the tribals and other dwellers of the forest with the protection and conservation of Wildlife; and]
 - (d) In any other matter connected with the protection of Wildlife which may be referred to it by the State Government.

The non-official members of the Board are entitled to DA/TA at the rate admissible to Grade-I officer for performance of the above duties.

The duration of the term of the Board will be 3 (three) years with effect from the date of issue of this notification.
