NOTIFICATION

No. B.13011/102/2015-DMR, the 15th of May, 2024: In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 14 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to reconstitute the State Disaster Management Authority for Mizoram consisting of the following members with immediate effect:

1. Chief Minister Chairman 2. Minister, DM&R, Home Vice-Chairman 3. Minister, PWD Member 4. Minister, Health & Family Welfare Member 5. Minister of State, Power & Electricity, C&I Member 6. Minister of State, FCS&CA Member 7. Minister of State, PHE Member

8. Chief Secretary/ Chairman, State Executive Committee - Member Secretary

TERMS OF REFERENCE:

1. The term of office of the State Authority shall be 3 years.

2. Powers and Functions:

Subject to the provisions of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the State Authority shall be responsible for the following.

- i) Lay down the State. Disaster Management Policy.
- ii) Approve the State Plan in accordance with the guidelines laid down by the National Authority.
- iii) Approve the Disaster Management Plans prepared by the State Government Departments,
- iv) Lay down guidelines to be followed by the State Government Departments for the purpose of integration of measures for prevention provide necessary technical assistance therefore.
- v) Coordinate the implementation of the State Plan.
- vi) Recommend provision of funds for mitigation and preparedness measures,
- vii) Review the development plans of different State Government Departments and ensure that prevention and mitigation measures are integrated therein.
- viii) Review the measures being taken for mitigation, capacity building and preparedness by the State Government Departments and issue such guidelines as may be necessary.
- ix) Lay down Guidelines for providing standards of relief to persons affected by disaster in the State, provided that such standards shall in no case be less than the minimum standards in the Guidelines laid down by the National Authority.

Ex-328/2024 - 2 -

- 3. Subject to ex-post facto ratification by the State Authority, the Chairperson shall, in case of emergency, have the power to exercise all or any of the powers of the State Authority.
- 4. The State Authority shall meet twice a year before the onset of monsoon season and at the end of monsoon season.

This notification supersedes earlier notification issued vide even no. dt. 18.5.2022.
