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NOTIFICATION

No.A.11018/1/2017/LESD&ED. In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 16 of the Mizoram Youth Commission Act, 2008 (No. 8 of 2008), the Government of Mizoram hereby make the following rules for regulating the duties, functions, honorarium and allowances payable to and another terms and conditions of service of the Chairperson and Members of the Mizoram Youth Commission, namely :

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| Short title, extent and Commencement | 1. | (1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Youth Commission Rules, 2019.
(2) They shall extend to the whole of Mizoram.
(3) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. |
| Definitions | 2. | In these rules unless the context otherwise requires-
(1) "Act" means Mizoram Youth Commission Act, 2008.
(2) "Commission" means the Mizoram Youth Commission constituted under Section 3 of the Act.
(3) "Chairperson" means the Chairperson of the Commission.
(4) "Member" means the member of the Commission.
(5) "Member Secretary" means Member Secretary of the Commission, who shall be a Government Servant.
(6) "Committee" means the committee appointed by the Commission.
(7) "Government" means the Government of Mizoram. |
| Honorarium | 3. | The Chairperson, other than a sitting MLA, shall be paid a fixed honorarium as may be decided by the Government from time to time. |
| Sitting Allowance and Other entitlements | 4. | (1) The Chairperson and Members shall be entitled to sitting allowance at the rate of rupees one thousand per sitting subject to a maximum of rupees three thousand per month or as may be decided by the Government from time to time. |

- (2) The Commission may invite any expert to attend its sittings or depute any experts to represent the interest of the Commission. Such expert may be paid an allowance of rupees one thousand per day or as may be decided by the Government from time to time.
- (3) The Chairperson other than sitting MLA shall be eligible for Traveling Allowance and Daily Allowance (TA&DA) at the same rates as are applicable to Secretary to the Government of Mizoram. Other members of the Commission shall be entitled to TA&DA at the rates admissible to Joint Secretary to the Government of Mizoram while performing duties.
- Tenure of Office 5. (1) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (1) of Section 4 of the Act, any person who has not attained the age of sixty-five years, may be appointed by the Government as the Chairperson or as a Member.
- (2) Subject to the provisions of sub-section (3) of Section 4 of the Act, the Chairperson and every member, shall, unless removed from office under sub-section (3) of section 4 of the Act, hold office for a term not exceeding three years at a time or till he/she attains the age of sixty-five years, whichever is earlier.
- (3) If the Chairperson is unable to discharge his/her functions owing to illness or other incapacity, the Government shall nominate any other Member to act as the Chairperson and the Member so nominated shall hold office of the Chairperson until the Chairperson resumes office.
- (4) If vacancy occurs in the office of the Chairperson due to death or resignation or as a result of removal under sub-section (4) of section 4 of the Act, the State Government shall nominate any other Member to act as the Chairperson until the vacancy is filled by a fresh appointment under sub-section (1) of section (4) of the Act.
- Member - Secretary 6. (1) Subject to the provision of sub-section (5) of Section 3 of the Act, Member Secretary of the Commission shall be an Officer of the rank of Deputy Secretary to the Government and shall be depute from amongst Officers of the Government with desired experience/qualifications.
- (2) Member Secretary shall be a full time official of the Commission, and he/she shall be entitled to all the usual pay and allowances and other facilities as admissible under the rules governing to his/her Service.
- (3) The member Secretary shall be the Controlling Officer in respect of the officers and staff of the Commission. The Member Secretary shall be the Drawing and Disbursing Officer of the Commission or any other officer in the Commission nominated by him/her.
- Staff of the Commission 7. (1) The Govt. shall provide the Commission with such officers and other employees as may be necessary.
- (2) Recruitment/filling up of posts etc is to be done by State Government.

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| Salaries and allowances | 8. | <p>(1) The salary/wages payable to officers and other staff of the Commission, who are appointed on regular/deputation/contract/MR basis and those on part time employment shall be determined by the Commission with due approval of the Government from time to time. The rate of such pay and allowances/salary/wages shall normally be equivalent to the pay and allowances/salary/wages in regards to their respective equivalent posts/grades under the Government by issue of a special or general order.</p> <p>(2) In case of official tour, they shall be entitled to TA&DA as admissible to Government employees of the corresponding rank.</p> <p>(3) Leave entitlement shall be as per CSS (Leave) Rules, 1972 as amended from time to time, and no other leave of any kind shall be admissible to any contract employee.</p> |
| Pension & Other Retirement | 9. | The Commission shall, in consultation with the Government, frame necessary rules/regulations/scheme relating to pension and other retirement benefits for the different categories of employees of the Commission; or by adoption of the appropriate rule or scheme or the Government. |
| Quarterly meeting | 10 | The Commission shall hold a quarterly review meeting to evaluate and monitor the progress for development of Mizoram Youth Commission and report to the Government. |
| Audit | 11. | The Commission shall submit its Audited Annual Financial Report duly authenticated by Chief Controller of Accounts, Accounts & Treasuries, Mizoram within 3 months form closing of the Financial Year. |
| Annual Report | 12. | The Commission shall submit Annual Report within 3 months from closing of the Financial Year. |
| Residuary Provisions | 13. | <p>(1) The conditions of service of the Chairperson and Members for which no expressed provision has been made in these rules shall be determined by the Government from time to time.</p> <p>(2) Any other matter for which no expressed provision has been made in these rules, shall be regulated in such manner as the Government May determine from time to time.</p> |

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
