1. The Committee shall file their reports on the timeline and budget required for implementation of the guidelines along with responsible authority/department.
2. The Committee may quantify required finances/funding for implementation of SAP through mobilization of funds through convergence of Central and State Schemes.
3. Private financing and grants may be explored. SAP may also include the climate co- benefits in terms of reduction of CO2 equivalent to attract more investments from financial institutions and private organizations. Finance Department may allocate specific budget for implementation of SAP.
4. Preparation of SAP undertaken by the Committee to be approved by the Steering Committee.
5. The Committee shall monitor the implementation of SAP periodically and report to Steering Committee which will review the progress of implementation of SAP.
