#### NOTIFICATION

**No. A.33023/3/2023-HTE(MSB), the 14<sup>th</sup> October, 2024:** In supersession of all previous notifications and orders on Incentive Cash Award Scheme and as a general policy to envisage proactive measures and to encourage educated youth who are citizens of India and bonafide residents of Mizoram, the Government of Mizoram has decided to provide financial assistance to promote entries in the Central and All India Services for a candidate who passed examinations conducted by Union Public Service Commission at various Centres as follows, namely :-

**1. Short title and commencement:-** 1) This Scheme may be called the Government of Mizoram Incentive Cash Award Scheme, 2024 To Successful Candidates for Central and All India Service examination.  
2) It shall come into force from the date of notification by the State Government.

**2. Objectives:-** To encourage educated youth among the citizens of India and bonafide residents of Mizoram who aspire to succeed entry to Central and All India Services.

**3. Application:-** The Scheme shall apply to the citizens of India and bonafide residents of Mizoram who have successfully cleared any of the following examination conducted by the Union Public Service Commission:

- 1) Civil Service Examination.
- 2) Combined Defence Service (OTA-Officers Training Academy)
- 3) National Defence Academy and Naval Academic Examination
- 4) Combined Medical Service Examination
- 5) Central Police Forces (Asst. Commandants) Examination
- 6) Indian Economic/Indian Statistical Service Examination
- 7) Combined Geo-Scientist Examination
- 8) Section Officers (20% Direct recruitment by UPSC).

**4. Implementing Authority:-** The scheme shall be implemented and administered by the Mizoram Scholarship Board in accordance with the regulation in force.

**5. Eligibility Criteria:-**

- 1) The applicant should be a bonafide citizen of the State of Mizoram.
- 2) The applicant shall not be an employee under the Union or State Government or any Government aided Public Service Undertaking or Board etc. at the time of appearing for the exam.
- 3) The applicant shall not be covered under any scholarship or incentive Scheme implemented by the Union or State Government.
- 4) The applicant shall be entitled to two chances i.e. clearance of Preliminary exam twice and Mains exam twice. However, an applicant shall be entitled to claim for only one examination at a time.
- 5) The applicant shall submit his claim in the prescribed form within a period of 3 (three) months from the date of declaration of results to the Secretary, Mizoram Scholarship Board.

**6. Value of Scholarship :-**

- 1) The Incentive Cash Award shall be Rs. 1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh) for one time clearance of an exam or as determined by the Government from time to time.
- 2) The applicant who have attended coaching for preparation of preliminary exam shall be entitled to reimbursement of actual fees paid to the coaching institution or Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees twenty thousand) only, whichever is less. Reimbursement can be claimed only once and will not be granted on the second attempt.
- 3) Uniform payment of hostel or mess fee at the rate of Rs.2000/- (Rupees two thousand) per month shall be given towards reimbursement subject to production of actual payment receipt. Payment for reimbursement of hostel or mess fees should be restricted to the limit of 6 (six) months only. Reimbursement can be claimed only once and will not be granted on the second attempt.

**7. Mode of Payment :-**

Claim should be made in the prescribed form and subject to verification of all claimed documents, Payment will be made by Secretary, Mizoram Scholarship Board through E-Payment.

**8. Mode of application :-**

The Application form shall be obtained from the Office of the Secretary, Mizoram Scholarship Board, Mizoram and the following documents, after duly attested, should be enclosed in the applications:

- i) Copy of Aadhaar or any other identification paper or document
- ii) Copy of Call letter or Intimation letter
- iii) Copy of permanent Residential Certificate
- iv) Copy of Receipt of Course Fee etc.

**9. Reservation &  
Right to the Scheme :-**

Notwithstanding anything contained in this scheme, the Incentive Cash Award under this scheme cannot be claimed as a

matter of right and the rights to its amendment, continuation or abolition is reserved by the Government.

**10. Interpretation:**

In the event of any difficulty arising in the interpretation of this scheme the decision of the Government shall be final and binding.
