In addition to the above, the chairman may co-opt any other official/ non-official as invitee in any of the meeting of the committee as may be deemed necessary. Non-official members shall be entitled sitting allowance of Rs. 1,000/- (one thousand) per meeting.

### Terms of references are as enumerated below:

- 1. To undertake a holistic assessment of the present operation and maintenance of the Airport and its future requirements.
- 2. To study the operation and maintenance of Airports in other States especially in the North East with special focus on the performance and experiences with Airport Authority of India (AAI) or any private company/ consortium.
- 3. To examine the viability of handing over the Lengpui Airport to Airport Authority of India (AAI) or to any private company/ consortium and the preferable entity (AAI or other private company/ consortium) to hand over the Airport.

- 4. To examine the processes that would have to be followed by Government of Mizoram to hand over the Airport to another entity.
- 5. To assess the feasibility or possibility of operation and maintenance of the Airport in the hands of the State Government as before.

The committee shall submit its report to the Government within 3 (three) months from the date of its first sitting.
