#### NOTIFICATION

**No. B-17012/54/2024-LR,S&WC(A), the 18<sup>th</sup> October, 2024:** In pursuance of the approval of the Council of Ministers in its meeting held on 16.10.2024 and circulated vide No.J.11011/1/2024-POL/Vol-I dt. 17.10.2024, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to create the **Chief Minister's Rubber Mission** with an aim to boost rubber plantation and production, to enhance value addition, to create employment opportunities, and to improve the socio-economic condition of the people involved in rubber cultivation within the state.

2. The Rubber Board, Ministry of Commerce & Industries, Govt. of India has proposed for implementation of a project for rubber plantation development in 2 lakh hectares in North East with support from the tyre manufacturing industry. The salient features of the proposed scheme are as follows:
  - i) Total target of rubber plantation : 2,00,000 Ha  
in North Eastern Region
  - ii) Target for Mizoram : 11500 Ha.
  - iii) Time period : 5 (five) years starting from 2024-2028
  - iv) Funding Quality improvement : Initiatives will be taken towards R&D, Initiatives training and capacity building for improvement of quality and grade of rubber being produced by the local planters in various clusters to ensure better prices to the rubber growers.
3. Under the Chief Minister's Rubber Mission in Mizoram, Rubber Plantation covering 11500 Ha. will be taken up in 5 (Five) years span. The Plantation shall be taken up on the available land, allotment land, community lands, and re-plantation mode wherever senile plantations exist under different implementing agencies for the next 5 (five) years beginning from the financial year 2024.
4. The Land Resources, Soil & Water Conservation Department, Govt. of Mizoram will function as the Nodal Department for all co-ordination purposes and the Director, Land Resources, Soil & Water Conservation Department is designated as State Nodal Officer for the project in Mizoram.

5. Rubber Plantations shall also be taken up as far as possible, in convergence with the funding from other schemes wherever beneficiaries is found eligible.
