No.A.14018/11/2024-SWD, the 4th November, 2024: In exercise of the powers conferred under Sub - Section (5) of Section 6 of the Scheduled Tribes & Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to reconstitute District Level Committee with the following members with immediate effect and until further orders:

Functions of the District Level Committee :

The District Level Monitoring Committee shall-

1. Ensure that the requisite information under Clause(b) of rule 6 of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional of Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Rules, 2008 has been provided to Gram Sabha or Forest Rights Committee;
2. Examine whether all claims, especially those of primitive tribal groups, pastoralists and nomadic tribes, have been addressed keeping in mind the objectives of the Act.
3. Consider and finally approve the claims and record of forest rights prepared by the Sub-Divisional Level Committee.
4. Hear petitions from persons aggrieved by the orders of the Sub-Divisional Level Committee.
5. Co-ordinate with other districts regarding inter-district claims;
6. Issue directions for incorporation of the forest rights in the relevant governemnt records including record of rights;
7. Ensure publication of the records of forest rights as may be finalized; and
8. Ensure that a certified copy of the record of forest rights and title under the Act, as specified in Annexure II & III to the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional of Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Rules, 2008, is provided to the concerned claimant and the Gram Sabha respectively.
