NOTIFICATION

No. 12018/89/2023-P&AR (GSW), the 13th November, 2024: In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Mizoram Police Radio Organisation (Group 'D' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1985 notified in the Mizoram Gazette extraordinary issue number 30(A)/85 dated 9.8.1985, in so far as they relate to the post of Constable (Painter), Constable (Tin Smith), Constable (Carpenter), Constable (Mast Lakher) and Constable (General Duty), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Governor of Mizoram hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Head Constable (General Duty) and Constable (General Duty) under Home Department, Government of Mizoram namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.-

(1) These rules may be called the Mizoram Police (Home) Department (Group 'C' Non-Ministerial posts of Head Constable and Constable under Mizoram Police Radio Organization) Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. Application.-

These rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column I of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix or pay scale.-

The number of the said posts, classification and level in the pay matrix or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in Column 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.
4. Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.-

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in Column 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.
5. Intial constution.-

The incumbents holding the post of Head Constable on regular basis on the date of commencement of these rules shall be deemed to have been appointed under these rules to the said post and the services rendered by them in the said post before the commencement of these rules shall be

taken into account for deciding their period of probation, seniority and eligibility for promotion to the next higher post.

6. Disqualification.-

No person –

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the State Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other valid grounds for doing so, exempt any such person from the operation of this rule.

7. Training and Departmental Examination.-

Every officials recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

8. Power to transfer.-

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the State Government, in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officials, so recruited under these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

9. Power to relax.-

Where the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, through the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

10. Saving.-

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
