## **NOTIFICATION**

**No.B.19011/92/2013-IND, the 13<sup>th</sup> January, 2014.** In pursuance of the Govt. of India, Ministry of Mines, Director's D.O.No.16/80/2009-M-VI dt.1.10.2013, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to constitute "Crisis Management Group" for the State of Mizoram comprising the following members to handle all mining accidents which are serious enough to be taken up at State level.

1. Chairman : Principal Secretary/Secretary, Geology & Mineral

Resources/Industries Deptt., Govt. of Mizoram

2. Member/Nodal Officer : Director, Geology & Mineral Resources, Mizoram

3. Member : (i) Joint Secretary, Home Department, Mizoram

(ii) Director, Fire & Emergency Services, Mizoram

(iii) Director, Disaster Management & Rehabilitation, Mizoram

(iv) Director, Health Services, Mizoram

The Crisis Management Group will be mainly responsible for dealing with crisis situation and for reporting all developments to the Chief Secretary of the State Government, seeking directions and guidance from the Government. They will also submit a report for assessing damages in the crisis affected area.

The Crisis Management Group shall meet at least once every year to review the preparedness of the various machineries for management of crisis in mines, and conduct surprise visit to at least five mines in a year. They will also publish annual report on the preparedness of the Government to handle the crisis giving all important details.
