Terms of reference of the Committee will be as follows:

1. Identification of shelf of projects:

- a. To collate the list of available land/sites for establishment of demonstration centre at district level using Agrotextile product across the North Eastern States.
- b. Coordinate and consult with the regional Agriculture Universities/KVKs/NGOs to set up such farm and encourage farmers to visit these demonstration centres.
- c. Based on the identified collated, the committee should develop a database which has the site details as per template at Annex-II (enclosed herewith). This template should be shared with the CEO: Agrotech and Ministry of Textiles.

2. Techno Economic Viability study:

- a. To assist in identifying suitable products for protective cultivation in NER.
- b. Provide cost-benefit analysis to the cultivators on usage of these products.

3. Availability of Agrotech in North Eastern Region:

a. To check for the availability of required Agrotech material in NE region, and identify the key suppliers in the region and on a pan India basis.

b. To ensure adequate and smooth supply chain of Agrotextiles material for establishment of demonstration centres and agrotextiles kits.

4. Establishment of institutional framework for implementing the projects:

- a. To identify different stakeholders and assign responsibilities to each for successful establishment of the demonstration centres.
- b. To develop a mechanism for inter-stakeholder coordination and establishing linkages with various manufacturers, user departments Agriculture university, KVKs, NGOs etc.
- c. Coordinate with various stakeholders to ensure the identification of beneficiaries for Agrotextile kits and transparent distribution of kits.
