NOTIFICATION

No.B.13018/I/2011-AGR/309, the 25th April, 2014. On expiry of the tenure of the existing State Fertilizer Committee constituted vide this Department Notification No. B.13018/2/2007-AGR Dt. 4.2.2009 and under the Proviso of Sub-clause(5) of Clause 38 of the Fertilizer (Control) Order 1985, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to reconstitute "State Fertilizer Committee" consisting of the following members:

1.

1) Director of Agriculture(Crop Husbandry), Mizoram	- Chairman
2) Director of Horticulture, Mizoram	- Member
3) Director of Soil & Water Conservation, Mizoram	- Member
4) Indian Micro-Fertilizer Manufacturers Association representative	- Member
5) Asst.Soil chemist, Department of Agriculture, Mizoram	- Member Secretary
2. Functions of the committee:
The Committee shall advice:
 - 1) The grades/ formulations of physical/ granulated mixtures of fertilizers that can be allowed to be prepared in the state.
 - 2) Requirement of Laboratory facilities in a manufacturing unit.
 - 3) Method of drawal and analysis of samples.
 - 4) Any other matter referred by the Central Government/ State Government to the committee.
3. The Committee may, subject to the previous approval of the Central Government, Central Fertilizer Committee make by law fixing the quorum and regulating its own procedure and the conduct of all business to be transacted by it.
4. The Committee may appoint one or more sub-committees, consisting wholly of members of the Committee or partly of the members of the Committee and partly of co-opted members as it thinks fit, for the purpose of discharging such of its function as may be delegated to such-committee or sub-committees by the State Fertilizer Committee.
5. The Committee shall closely watch the prevailing situation of illegal transportation of Fertilizer and to take necessary steps as and when necessary in addition to the duties and responsibilities laid down in the Fertilizer Control Order 1985.
6. The term of the Committee shall be five years from the date of its publication in the official gazette.
