10. Child Development Project Officer.
11. Elected Representative of Village Council to be nominated by the chairman.
12. One representative of the LADC/CADC/MADC (in their respective DPCs)
13. Two women Village Council Panchayat member to be nominated by the Chairman.

The terms of references for the District Planning Committee on RGPSA are as under:

1. Formulation of the District Level Plan under RGPSA and making recommendations to the state Executive Committee.
2. Review and monitoring of works executed under RGPSA
3. Power and Liberty to draw up developmental Projects and schemes considered necessary for successful implementation of RGPSA in the Village/ Panchayat level.
4. To address any grievance within Village Council/ Panchayati Raj in the District.
5. To oversee the implementation of the scheme for developing strong Panchayati Raj/ Village Council system within the District.

6. Strengthening/ Promoting the status of women and minorities within the District.
7. Ensuring timely release of fund and regular Social Audit.
8. To Promote appropriate tax, fee etc. infrastructure and capacity building of Village Council/ Panchayati Raj.
9. To ensure Right based entitlement to Panchayati Raj/ Village Council including women and child rights.
