THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (2nd VOTE ON ACCOUNT) ACT, 2014

ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services for another four months of the Financial Year, 2014-2015 i.e August to November, 2014.

It is enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Sixty-Fifth year of the Republic of India as follows :-

| Short Title | 1. (1) This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (2nd Vote on Account) Act, 2014. |
| Issue of ^ 23778883000/- out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for four months of the Financial Year, 2014-2015 i.e August to November, 2014. | 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram, there may be paid and applied the sums not exceeding those as specified in column (5) of the Schedule to this Act, amounting, in the aggregate, to the sum of <i>Rupees two thousand three hundred seventy seven crore eighty eight lakh eighty three thousand</i> only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment for four months of the Financial Year, 2014-2015 i.e August to November, 2014 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule |
| Appropriation | 3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period. |
