THE MIZORAM APPROPRIATION (VOTE ON ACCOUNT) ACT, 2015

(ACT NO. 3 OF 2015)

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State for the services for the first four months of the Financial Year, 2015-2016 (i.e April to July, 2015).

It is enacted by the Legislative Assembly of Mizoram in the Sixty Sixth Year of the Republic of India as follows :-

Short title

Appropriation

1. This Act may be called the Mizoram Appropriation (Vote on Account) Act, 2015

From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram,

there may be paid and applied the sums not exceeding those as

specified in column (5) of the Schedule to this Act, amounting,

Issue of ` **327722.61 lakh/**out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram for the first four months of the Financial Year, 2015-2016 (i.e April to July, 2015)

in the aggregate, to the sum of **Rupees three thousand two hundred seventy seven crore twenty two lakh sixty thousand** only for defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment for the first four months of the Financial Year, 2015-2016 (i.e. April to July, 2015) in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Mizoram by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said period.
