NOTIFICATION

No. A. 12018/81/2011-P&AR(GSW), the 14th May, 2013. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram after consultation with the Mizoram Public Service Commission is pleased to make the following Rules further to amend the Mizoram Police Department (Group 'B' post) Recruitment Rules, 2004 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules) relating to recruitment to the post of Forensic Science Assistant (now re-designated as Junior Scientific Officer) Notified vide No. A. 12018/46/2004-P&AR(GSW)/Vol/Pt dt. 28.2.2005 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Extraordinary Issue No. 36 dt. 1.3.2005, namely:-

1.	Short title and 1. (1) Commencement (2)	These Rules may be called the Mizoram Police Department (Group 'B' Posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2013. They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Mizoram Gazette.
2.	Amendment of Rule 1	In Sub-Rule (1) of Rule 1 of the Principal Rules, the following shall be substituted, namely:- "(1) These Rules may be called the Government of Mizoram Home (Forensic) Department (Group 'A' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2013.
3.	Amendment of Annexure-I	For the existing columns 1, 2, 4, 7, 8 and 13 of the First Schedule of the Principal Rules, the following shall be substituted, namely: "Col. 1: Junior Scientific Officer (Serology) Junior Scientific Officer (Toxicology) Junior Scientific Officer (Chemistry) Junior Scientific Officer (Questioned Document) Junior Scientific Officer (Ballistics & Tool marks)
