NOTIFICATION

No.B.12021/10/11-TRP, the 8th May, 2015. Pursuant to the Carriage by Road Rules, 2011 as notified by the Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways on 28.2.2011 to introduce Compulsory Registration of Common Carriers System in India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make and notify the Scheme for the implementation of the Carriage by Road Rules, 2011 under Carriage by Road Act, 2007 in the State of Mizoram :-

1. These Scheme shall be called "The Implementation of Compulsory Registration of Common Carriers in the State of Mizoram Scheme, 2015".
2. The Scheme shall come into force on such date as the State Govt. may issue by Notification in the Official Gazette.
3. State Transport Authority will be the Registering Authority and will start registration of common carriers.
4. No person shall engage in the business of a common carrier after the commencement of this act unless he has been granted a certificate of registration.
5. Any person who is engaged, whether wholly or partly, in the business of a common carrier, immediately before commencement of this act shall apply for registration within 30 days from the date of commencement.
6. Whoever contravene the provisions of Sections or a notifications issued under Section 14 shall be punishable.
7. The procedure and the level at which the approval has to be granted is given below:-
 - a) The applicant shall deposit the fee with the Account Branch of STA/MV wing.
 - b) The applicant shall submit the application form along with the receipt issued by Account Branch to STA Branch.
 - c) After ensuring that all the formalities are fulfilled by the applicant, a registration certificate will be issued
