#### NOTIFICATION

**No.12018/59/2006-P&AR(GSW), the 8<sup>th</sup> May, 2015.**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Mizoram Science, Technology and Environment Wing, Planning Department (Group 'A') Recruitment Rules, 2007 (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Rules) notified vide No.A. 12018/54/2005-P&AR(GSW), dt.31.5.2007 and published in the Mizoram Gazette Extra Ordinary Issue No. 160, dt.4.6.2007 relating the post of **Chief Scientific Officer** namely :-

**1. Short title and Commencement**

- (1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Science, Technology and Environment Wing, Planning Department (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2015
- (2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. Amendment of First Schedule**

- (1) In the first schedule of the Principal Rules, columns 4,11,12 & 13 shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

**“Column 4:** PB-4 Rs.37400-67000+8700 GP

**Column 11:** Promotion failing which by deputation

**Column 12:**

PROMOTION : From Principal Scientific Officer with not less than 5(five) years regular service in the grade failing which Principal Scientific Officer with 3(three) years of regular service in the grade and not less than 15 (fifteen) years of regular service calculated from the date of entry into Scientific Officer (Group 'A').

DEPUTATION : From Officers holding analogous posts in Central/State Government (Period of deputation shall ordinarily not exceed 3 (three) years
