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#### NOTIFICATION

**No.A. 34011/1/2015-P&AR(GSW), the 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2016.** In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, and all other powers enabling him in this behalf and in pursuance of Rule 4 of the Mizoram Home (Police) Department (Group 'A' posts), Recruitment Rules 2013, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following regulations, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement-
  - (1) These regulations may be called the Mizoram Home (Police) (Ministerial) Department (Group 'A' posts) (Limited Departmental Examination) Regulations, 2015.
  - (2) These Regulations shall come into force from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette
2. Definitions
  - (3) In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires:-
    - (a) "Commission" means the Mizoram Public Service Commission
    - (b) "Constitution" means the Constitution of India
    - (c) "Government" means the Government of Mizoram
    - (d) "Limited Departmental Examination" means examination conducted under these Regulations for filling up of 1/3 of posts of Mizoram Home (Police) Department (Group 'A' posts) (Dy. S.P.) (Ministerial)
    - (e) "Vacancies" means vacancies in the Dy. S.P (Ministerial) which are declared to be filled by promotion on the result of Limited Departmental Examination.
    - (f) "Scheduled Tribes" shall have the same meaning as assigned to it by clause 25 of Article 366 of the Constitution of India.
  - (2) Other words and expressions used in these Regulations and not defined herewith shall have meaning respectively assigned to them in the Mizoram Home (Police) Department (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2013.
3. Holding of Examination
  - (1) The examination shall be conducted by the Commission under these Regulations in the manner notified by the Government of Mizoram from time to time.

- (2) The date and venue of the examination shall be fixed by the Commission.
4. Conditions of eligibility
- In order to be eligible to compete Departmental Examination for filling up of 1/3 of the total sanctioned posts of Dy. S.P. (Ministerial), a candidate must be :-
- a) a citizen of India.
  - b) holding the post of Inspector (Ministerial) (Group 'B' Gazetted post) with not less than 5 years regular service in the grade.
5. Decision as to eligibility
- The decision of the Mizoram Public Service Commission as to the eligibility or otherwise of candidates for admission to the examination shall be final and no candidate to whom a certificate of admission has not been issued by the Mizoram Public Service Commission shall be admitted to the examination
6. Result
- (1) The names of the candidates who are considered by the Commission suitable for appointment on the results of the examination shall be arranged in the order of merit. They shall be recommended for appointment in that order up to the number of appointment required to be made. The order of merit shall be determined in accordance with aggregate marks obtained by each candidate and if two or more candidates obtained same marks in the examination, their names shall be arranged in the list according to their age or name in alphabetical order in case they are of the same age.
  - (2) The form and manner of communication of result of the examination to individual candidates shall be decided by the Government at its discretion.
  - (3) Success in the examination shall confer no right for appointment to posts of Dy. S.P. (Ministerial), unless the Government is satisfied to appoint him.
7. Penalty for misconduct
- A candidate who is or has been declared by the Commission to be guilty of:
- a) obtaining support for his candidature by any mean, or
  - b) impersonating, or
  - c) procuring impersonation by any persons, or
  - d) submitting fabricated documents which have been tampered with, or
  - e) making statements which are incorrect or false, or suppressing material information, or
  - f) resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his candidature for the examination, or
  - g) using unfair means in the examination hall, or

- h) misbehaving in the examination hall, or
  - i) attempting to commit or, abetting the Commission of all or any of the acts specified in the foregoing clause, as the case may be shall, in addition to rendering himself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable-
- 1) to be disqualified by the Commission from the examination for which he is candidate.
  - 2) to be debarred either permanently or for a specified period.

8. Syllabus

The Limited Departmental Examination for the post of Dy. S.P. (Ministerial) shall be conducted with the syllabus as set forth in the Appendix.
