No. B. 11015/1/2012-LE&IT, the 8th **April, 2013.** In exercise of the power conferred under section 5(1)(a) and as per section 7 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 and in supersession of this Department's Notification vide No. B. 11015/1/2009-L&E dt. 26.08.2010, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to reconstitute a State Level Committee on Minimum Wages to review Minimum Wages and advise the Govt. of Mizoram in respect of the re-fixation of Minimum Rates of Wages for persons working under any Schedule/Casual Employments within the State of Mizoram consisting of the following members.

The Terms of Reference of the Committee shall be as follows:

- 1. Review the prevailing rates of wages of persons engaged in Scheduled/Casual Employment considering Price Index in Local Market, etc.
- 2. Submit proposals to the Govt. of Mizoram for re-fixation of Minimum Wages of persons employed under any scheduled employment at interval of at least every 2 (two) years.
- 3. Recommended suitable enforcement machinery.
- 4. The terms of office of the Committee shall be for a period of 2 (two) years with effect from 01.01.2013 upto 31.12.2014.
- 5. Non-Official members of the Committee shall be entitled to TA & DA like Officers of the Govt.
- 6. The Committee shall submit its report/advice to the Govt. of Mizoram within 3 (three) months from its first sitting to consider revision of the existing Minimum Wages fixed by the Government from time to time.
