#### THE UTTARAKHAND APPROPRIATION (VOTE ON ACCOUNT) ACT, 2016

#### AN ACT

to provide for the withdrawal of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand for the services of a part of the financial year 2016-2017.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

Short title **1.** (*1*) This Act may be called the Uttarakhand Appropriation (Vote on Account) mencement. Act, 2016.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of April, 2016.

Withdrawal of Rs.13642, 43,85,000 from and out of the Schedule may be withdrawn sums not exceeding those specified in column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of thirteen thousand six hundred forty-two crore, forty-three lakh, eighty-five thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2016-2017 in respect of the services specified in column (2) of the Schedule.

Appropriation. **3.** The sums authorised to be withdrawn from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Uttarakhand by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.

Repeal and **4.** (1) The Uttarakhand Appropriation (Vote on Account) Ordinance, 2016 is Ord. 2 of 2016. hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the provisions of this Act.
