NOTIFICATION

No.J.25011/8/2016-EXC, the 10th March, 2017. In the interest of Pubic Services and on the advice of the Review and Evaluation Committee of the MLPC Act, 2014 in its first meeting held on the 9.8.2016, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to constitute a "**Study Group**" of MLPC Act, 2014 to study the Socio-economic impacts and to evaluate the effect of the Mizoram Liquor Prohibition and Control Act, 2014 with immediate effect and until further orders.

It may be mentioned here that the Review and Evaluation Committee of the MLPC Act, 2014 has been renamed as "The State Prohibition Council" as per Sub-section (1) of Section 81 of the MLPC Act, 2014 vide this Department's Notification of even No.Dt.10.3.2017 (copy enclosed).

The Study Group will consist of the following members:

- 1. Pu Dominic Lalhmangaiha Member (Convener).
- 2. Lt. Col. (SA) Lalramhluna Member.
- 3. Dr. Laldinliana Varte (MZU) Member.
- 4. Dr. Lalbiakzuala (Surgeon) Member.

In addition to the above members, Under Secretary to the Government of Mizoram Excise & Narcotics Department may provide necessary secretarial/logistic assistance to the Study Group as required.

A sum of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Rupees five lakhs) only is initially earmarked for the Study Group to meet incidental expenditures. Members of the Study Group may be allowed to visit other States in connection with their study if they so desire.
