12. Joint Director (TP), Town & Country Planning
13. One representative each from CYMA/MUP/MHIP

16. Representative of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India
17. Representative of Central Pollution Control Board
18. Representative of National Institute of Technology, Mizoram
19. 3 Representatives from Local Bodies by rotation.

The duties and functions of the Committee shall be as below:-

- i. The State Level Advisory Body shall meet at least once in every six months to review the matters related to implementation of these rules, state policy and strategy on solid waste management and give advice to state government for taking measures that are necessary for expeditious and appropriate implementation of these rules.
- ii. The copies of the review report shall be forwarded to the State Pollution Control Board or Pollution Control Committee for necessary action.
