Terms of Reference :-

The State Level Task Force under the chairman of Commissioner & Secretary, Health & Family Welfare will meet once in six months for strategic/policy decisions based on the findings of the reviews.

- The State Level Task Force will review the implementation of Maternal and Child Death Review in the State.
- Discuss the action points generated by MDR and CDR process and make recommendations to Government for policy and Strategy formulations.

- The Interlinkages between the Maternal and Neonatal causes of death should be explored and a common set of recommendations be made to prevent them.
- The data from the districts compiled at the state level should be reviewed and trends observed and analyzed.
- The Action Taken Report on the Minutes of last meeting of the State Task force should be presented by the SNO.
- Minutes of the meeting should be put on record. Key decisions and action points should be circulated to all stakeholders in various departments with clear timelines for action and steps forward.
- State operational issues/feedback with Government of India.
