The Board will dispose the cases of the children in conflict with law as per the procedure laid down under the Act and the Rules as amended from time to time notwithstanding that the Board may adopt a set Rules of procedure in conformity with the Act and the Rules for smooth functioning under intimation to the Constituting Authority.

The Board will hold its sittings in the premises of an Observation Home while dealing with the cases of children in conflict with law. In Districts where there is no Observation Home, the Board will hold its sittings at a suitable premise as the Board finds appropriate.

The Boards will have jurisdiction over their respective administrative districts.

The above three Boards will have a tenure of 3 (three) years from the date of issue of this Notification. The tenure of the Members will be Conterminus with the tenure of the Board.
