NOTIFICATION

No.A.12018/17/2011-P&AR(GSW), the 8th October,2012. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules relating the method of recruitment to the post (s) of **Librarian** under Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Mizoram, namely :-

- These rules may be called the Mizoram Health & Family Welfare 1. Short title and (1) Department (Group 'B' post) Recruitment Rules, 2012. commencement-(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette. These rules shall apply to the post(s) specified in column 1 of the 2. Application-Annexure - I annexed to these rules. 3. Number of posts, The number of the said post(s), their classification, pay band and Classification, pay grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in band Columns 2 to 4 of the Annexure - I. band and grade pay/Pay scale-
- Method of recruitment, age limit, Qualifications, etc-

The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in Column 5 to 14 of the Annexure - I.

Provided that the upper age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Government of Mizoram, from time to time.

5. Disqualification-

- No person-(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who, having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post(s);

(Training and	Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rules.
6. Training and departmental	Every Government servant recruited under these rules shall undergo
examination-	such training or pass such departmental examination as may be prescribed from time to time.
7. Power to transfer	
and posting-	Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officer so recruited under these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.
8. Power to relax-	
	Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, he may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in wiriting in consultation with the Department of Personnel & Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.
9. Reservation and	
other concessions	Nothing in these rules shall affect any reservation and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Caste/the Scheduled Tribes and other category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.
