## NOTIFICATION

No. A.12018/23/2003-P\&AR(GSW), the $\mathbf{2 7}^{\text {th }}$ January, 2012. In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Mizoram is pleased to make the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post(s) of Jailor and Assistant Jailor under Prison Department, Government of Mizoram, namely :-

## 1. Short Title and Commencement

2. Application
3. Number of posts, classification, pay band
and grade pay/pay scale classification, pay band
and grade pay/pay scale
4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc-
(1) These Rules may be called the Mizoram Prison Department (Group ' B ' posts) Recruitment Rules, 2011.
(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

These rules shall apply to the posts specified in Column 1 of the Annexure-I annexed to these rules.

The number of the said post(s), their classification, Pay Band and Grade pay/pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Annexure-I.

The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post(s) shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Annexure-I.

Provided that the age limit prescribed for direct recruitment may be relaxed in the case of candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes/the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government or the Government of Mizoram from time to time.

No person-
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any other person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post(s);
6. Training and Departmental Examination.
7. Powers to transfer
8. Power to relax
9. Reservation and other concessions
10. Repeal and Savings

Provided that the Governor may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and to the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

Every Government servant recruited under these rules shall undergo such training or pass such Departmental Examination as may be prescribed from time to time.

Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Governor of Mizoram, in public interest, shall have the right and power to transfer any officer so recruited under these rules to any other post or position which is equivalent in rank or grade.

Where the Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Department of Personnel \& Administrative Reforms, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes/the Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the CentralGovernment or the Government of Mizoram from time to time in this regard.

All rules pertaining to these posts framed by the Government of Mizoram issued under Memo No. HMJ. 23/73/Pt.I dated 9.10.1978 published in the Mizoram Gazette Vol. VII Issue No. 41 dated 3.10.1978.

Provided that any order made or anything done or any action taken under the rules so repealed, or under any general orders ancillary thereto, shall be deemed to have been made, done or taken under the corresponding provisions of these rules.
