THE APPROPRIATION (RAILWAYS) NO. 2 ACT, 2011

AN ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of India for the services of the financial year 2010-11 for the purposes fo Railways.

Be it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-second Year of the Republic of India as follows:-

1. This Act may be called the Appropriation (Railways) No. 2 Act, 2011.

Short title

2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of India there may by paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 3 of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sum of one lakh ninety-seven thousand five hundred one crores, sixty-seven lakhs and thirty-three thousand rupees towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year 2011-12, in respect of the services relating to Railways specified in column 2 of the Schedule.

Issue of Rs.197501,67, 33,000 out of the Consolidated Fund of India for the financial year

3. The sums authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Appropriation India by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes expressed in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
